1. To receive apologies for absence.

2. Declaration of Interest or dispensations on any items(s).

Cllr A Higgs declared an interest in Planning. Cllr D Morgan declared an interest in Tarragan, Gilfach Community Centre, Young @ Heart. Cllr S Hamer-Thomas declared an interest in Greater Bargoed Partnership, Friends of Greater Bargoed. Cllr R Carroll declared an interest in All Allotments in the Greater Bargoed area and Tarragan.

3. Police Report.

The Mayor welcomed Inspector Paul Biggs to the meeting. The Inspector has been in post four weeks; he provided Members with a brief synopsis of his experience prior to taking up this post and explained his priorities for the first three months. Members congratulated the Inspector and wished him luck in the new role.

- 4. To Welcome Sean Davies (CCBC Sports Development Team) to the meeting. Sean Davies was welcomed to the meeting and invited to give his presentation on holiday schemes in Caerphilly County Borough. Mr Davies explained that participation has been increasing year on year with very positive parental feedback being received throughout. The schemes also offer sport leader opportunities for older children. Mr Davies circulated information on the sport schemes being proposed for town council consideration. Members enquired about the possibility of an additional venue for delivery as an alternative to Heolddu. Mr Davies provided details of costs for the Hangar in Aberbargoed for Members also to consider. He also explained that as an additional element to the sports scheme the team also invite the emergency services to come along and take part in the activities with the children, this promotes awareness and helps break down some of the barriers.
- 5. To approve and sign the Minutes of the Full Council Meeting 25th September 2019. The minutes were approved and signed by the Mayor.
- 6. To discuss arrangements for Remembrance Services 2019. RESOLVED Cllr Halvey to lay the wreath in Aberbargoed. RESOLVED The Mayor to lay the wreath in St Gwladys Church, Bargoed. RESOLVED The Deputy Mayor to lay the wreath in Gilfach. The Deputy Mayor also advised Members of the Archbishop attendance at St Margarets Church Gilfach, service to commence 9.30am.

7. Mayors Report.

The Mayor attended the flower festival at St Margarets church, Gilfach. He advised of putting out the poppies throughout Bargoed town centre and of the broken poppies from 2018 having been recycled for use this year. In respect of the Winter Fair, Members RESOLVED to accept all 8 recommendations from the working group.
