Gall unrhyw un sydd wedi cofrestru gyda Meddyg Teulu yn ardal Bwrdd Iechyd Prifysgol Aneurin Bevan fynychu. Mae hyn yn cynnwys plant 12 oed a'n hŷn sydd angen eu dos cyntaf neu ail ddos. Cofiwch:

- - Gall oedolion 18+ oed gael yr ail ddos 8 wythnos ar ôl y dos cyntaf; a rhaid bod 28 diwrnod wedi mynd heibio ers y cawsoch eich heintio â COVID-19, os yw hynny'n berthnasol.
- - Gall unigolion 12-17 oed gael yr ail ddos 12 wythnos neu fwy ar ôl eu dos cyntaf, neu 12 wythnos ar ôl cael eu heintio â COVID-19.
- - Cewch ddod am eich dos atgyfnerthu 13 wythnos ar ôl eich ail ddos; a rhaid bod 28 diwrnod wedi mynd heibio ers y cawsoch eich heintio â COVID-19, os yw hynny'n berthnasol.

Walk-in Vaccination Clinics

Good morning,

Please see information below regarding new confirmed walk-in vaccination clinics.

Tuesday 8th March 2022, 12:30pm – 4:00pm

Wednesday 9th March 2022, 9:30am - 4:00pm

Thursday 10th March 2022, 12:30pm - 4:00pm

Friday 11th March 2022, 9:30am - 4:30pm

First, Second and Booster doses available at walk-in vaccination clinics next week at Newport, Cwmbran, Ebbw Vale and Pontllanfraith Mass Vaccination Centres.

Anyone who is registered with a GP in the Aneurin Bevan University Health Board area can attend. This includes children aged 12 and above who need their first or second dose.

Remember:

- Second doses for adults 18+ years are 8 weeks after your 1st dose; and you need to be 28 days post a COVID-19 infection.
- Second doses for 12-17year olds must be 12 weeks or more after their first dose or 12 weeks after having Covid-19 infection.
- Booster dose is 13 weeks after your 2nd dose; and you need to be 28 days post a COVID-19 infection.
