4. The Chair then moved to appoint Cllr Davies as Deputy Chair. RESOLVED
5. Chair approved and signed the Minutes of the Events and Environment Committee meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
6. Received feedback and evaluated recent jubilee event, it was discussed on how to advertise future events and how to proceed through lessons learnt from this one.
7. Instructions to the Assistant Clerk on moving forward with:

7.2: To fully support the installation of geocache at Bargoed Urban Park. To gain co-operation of Heolddu school in its initial setup and to co-operate with the geocache installation team and approach full council for funding. RESOLVED. (Cllr H-Thomas excused herself at this point)

Chocolate alternatives due to Government guidance for tackling obesity to be considered. Four sleigh venues, food vendors, salvation army and local choirs, CCBC highways to be contacted

10. Verbal update received from the Assistant Clerk on the CCBC summer sports programme for children. Asst Clerk awaiting clarification on Government funding and approaching County regarding roller skating lessons to tie in with roller rink at Christmas
