Overall, there has been a positive reduction in both crime and ASB in Bargoed & Aberbargoed since our last meeting which has been replicated across most of the wards within the Caerphilly North Section. After an incredibly busy August we are starting to see our crime and incident reports return to average figures.

As a result, the Neighbourhood teams have been able to focus on their proactive work and increased visibility across the Bargoed and Aberbargoed Wards.

Bargoed Neighbourhood Officers have been actively involved in Town Safe patrols throughout the evenings and have recently applied for and secured funding through the Positive Impact Fund to assist in these patrols and support their engagement with members of our community enjoying the Town Centre and Night-time Economy services through the evenings and weekends.

Despite some inclement weather they have still been patrolling with a smile. The team will continue to link in with Businesses and Partners to support this ongoing work.



The team are continuing to focus on the issues that matter to you responding to the reports of ongoing issues of anti-social driving and off-road bikes. The team have recently seized a Quad that was being driven in an anti-social manner in Aberbargoed and also issued a Section 59 Anti-Social Driving warning to the driver of a vehicle committing an offence in Morrisons Car Park. Calls to Morrisons continue to decrease but we are still patrolling and responding to any matters reported here should they arise.



We have also been supported by Officers from the Roads Policing Team who arrested and charged 2 persons for drink driving and 2 persons from drug driving in September.





Our Community Support Officers are continuing to utilise the local CWTSH guide to interact with local groups in the area and have linked in with the local group 'The Daffodils' at the YMCA to arrange future training events with them.

The team are now making plans as we enter the window for Halloween activities and will conducting visible patrols to deter ASB, they will be working with local businesses in advance to ensure they assist us with responsible sales of eggs and flour during the build-up.

Finally, this month we also welcomed our new Bargoed & Aberbargoed Ward Manager PC Dan Evans. Pc Evans is an experienced Response officer and brings lots of skills and energy to our team. He will be prioritising Drug enforcement action across Gilfach and Bargoed in addition to further traffic operations across our wards. We will provide further updates on these in due course.
