# **Overview of Reported Crimes**

### **Overview of ASB**

ASB has remained at a similar number whilst there has been a significant decrease in crime from last month.

#### **Team Initiatives and Operations**

Caerphilly North Neighbourhood team have run an operation in Bargoed over the month of May due to the increase in calls during April for Morrisons. Historically there have been incidents of crime and ASB in this locality but positive work in 2021 stemmed this increase. There are concerns that the situation is now starting to escalate again supported by both the calls reported to Police and contact received directly from Elected Members and Members of Bargoed Town Council.

We targeted foot and mobile patrols in and around the vicinity offering words of advice and issuing Section 59's





#### **Operation Harley**

Op Harley is designed to tackle off road bikes, quads,4x4's as an ongoing operation. As part of our intelligence gathering, we have been out in the community knocking doors and delivering information on how to report this issue.

# **Community Engagement Events**

Officers held an event at Morrisons giving away vehicle packs and talking with local residents about how to keep their car and belongings safe.



#### **May Fair**
