- **How this helped your community.**

For example:

“We delivered weekly food parcels and made regular welfare calls to vulnerable residents. We are proud of the volunteer network that formed, which helped reduce isolation and ensured people felt supported during a very difficult time.”

We will use a small selection of quotes (with the council name) across One Voice Wales communications in the lead-up to the Day of Reflection and may feature some on our website as part of a short tribute page. If you have any photographs then please feel free to send them too, this is optional. There is absolutely no obligation to respond, again participation is entirely optional.
